

Pastor's February Notes

Lent 2024: "A Mind Awake"

Ash Wednesday February 14 through Holy Week (end of March)

Lenten Question:

How does Father God awaken us both to Abundant Life now and to Everlasting Life after we die?

Lenten Answer:

Father God himself awakens us by His Living Word, who is Jesus Christ, in unity with God's Holy Spirit!

Lenten scripture:

John 11:11 - "...Jesus said to them, 'Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep; but I go, so that I may awaken him out of sleep.'"

(This is the Word of the Lord! Thanks be to God!)

Indeed, thanks be to God for God's Living Word speaking to us through God's written word recorded in scripture.

Let's heed God's sobering/awakening Ash Wednesday declaration from scripture: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return!" (Genesis 3:19)

And let's, in accord with God's declaration, gather on Ash Wednesday, February 14th and receive ashes on our forehead, close to our minds, which God himself awakens through His Living Word, Jesus Christ. The ashes are imposed in the shape of a cross, indeed Christ Jesus's cross, reminding us that our most certain mortality (signified by the ashes) will receive from God to receive and put on immortality because of Christ's own cross and resurrection. At the 2nd Coming of Christ, Christ himself will usher in the resurrection of all the dead for the final judgment unto everlasting life. Those who have received Christ in faith will be judged righteous because Christ's righteousness and everlasting life with God is put onto our accounts through faith in Jesus Christ.

Death is sure in this life, but so is God's promise of our awakening and resurrection from the dead both now unto Abundant Life and also, at the last, unto everlasting life and peace with God and other believers through faith in the person and work of God's only Son, Christ Jesus!

Trust and follow Jesus. He gives you power, love, and self-control.


Simple SIPs with Pastor Chris

Safety & Security

Establishing A Foundation for Church Safety

If you have been or are a greeter or usher, you have had little or no background in emergency planning, protection or security activities.

You may be a senior-aged member or have a disability or illness, or you may be youthful and inexperienced in dealing with people who are upset. You may be friendly in a quiet way or assertively outgoing. You probably thought that the role as a greeter or usher would involve smiling, shaking hands, directing guests, passing the offering place and helping during services.

Fortunately, those will continue to be your primary tasks. However, greeters, ushers, elders, ministers, teachers and the pastor, all share responsibility for the safety and security of the congregation. You are not expected to do it all yourself or act as a police officer or security guard but you are expected to continuously observe people and the environment, assess the situation to see if there is danger and respond accordingly.

YOUR CHALLENGE IS TO FULTILL THE DUAL ROLES OF GREETER AND GUARDIAN.

You must be balanced in your approach. You must balance the need to provide a feeling of welcome and openness with being watchful and appropriately wary. Some are so unconcerned that they are rarely aware of what is happening around them, while others are so concerned that they are tense and on edge all the time
